Renovation of Potter's Lake public access site Informational meeting scheduled for April 25

MILWAUKEE – The Department of Natural Resources has approved funding for the renovation of the public boat access on Potter's Lake, a 162-acre lake located in town of East Troy in Walworth County. To provide additional information and gather input from local residents and other interested parties, the DNR will hold an informational meeting to on Thursday, April 25 at the East Troy Town Hall, N9330 Stewart School Rd. The informal meeting will be an open-house format and the public is invited to stop in any time between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. There will be no formal presentation, but department staff will be on hand to explain the project, answer questions and take comments.

The proposed development of this site includes installing a new accessible boarding dock and replacing the existing boat ramp.

In addition to taking comments at the April 25 meeting, the Department will accept written comments on the project until May 3, 2002.
